CODE OF ORDINANCES Town of HIGHLAND BEACH, FLORIDA Codified through Ordinance No. 703, adopted May 6, 2003. (Supplement No. 1) / Chapter 23 SIGNS AND ADVERTISING* / Sec. 23-7. Permitted signs.

Sec. 23-7. Permitted signs.

- (6) No temporary real estate signs shall be permitted except those erected by property owners or the owner's agent, and such signs shall be subject to the following conditions:
 - a. Not more than one sign shall be erected for each property.
 - b. The size of each sign shall be limited to an area not more than twelve (12) inches in height by eighteen (18) inches in width per side. Signs may be constructed to permit lettering on both front and rear, lettering shall be black on white background.
 - c. Signs are to be two-sided "swinging type" with posts to be one inch black angle-iron, six (6) feet in length with four (4) feet above ground from the top of sign when installed and with a piece of one inch by one inch by one-eighth (1/8) inch black angle-iron placed horizontally, four (4) feet from top of post (ground level).
 - d. Removal of signs after sale or rent, within five (5) working days.
 - e. One additional "open house" real estate sign shall be permitted for a forty-eight-hour period for sale of properties and is to be removed immediately after the two (2) day period. Such sign shall be of the same size, color and installation as set forth in b. and c. above.
