### FOOTNOTES

1. Applicable to all Bum Permits: In accordance with the Town's ordinance, the person kindling a fire under this permit is in no way relieved of legal responsibility if the fire is allowed to escape or cause damage to the property of another.
2. The burn permit may be revoked depending on changes in weather conditions – or directives from the Florida Division of Forestry
3. Bonfires are not permitted during Turtle Season (March 1<sup>st</sup>- October 31<sup>st</sup>)
