Notice of Special Referendum Election

Notice is hereby given that a Special Referendum Election has been called by the Town Commission of the Town of Highland Beach pursuant to Resolution No. 2021-023, and will be held on Tuesday, November 2, 2021, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at St. Lucy Catholic Church (polling location) located at 3510 South Ocean Boulevard, Highland Beach, Florida, 33487.

The purpose is for Highland Beach registered electors to cast their vote on the following ballot question:

ESTABLISHMENT AND FUNDING OF THE HIGHLAND BEACH FIRE AND
RESCUE DEPARTMENT

SHALL THE TOWN COMMISSION OF HIGHLAND BEACH BE AUTHORIZED TO EXPEND UP TO 10 MILLION DOLLARS TO ESTABLISH OUR OWN FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT BY EXPANDING THE EXISTING FIRE STATION AND ACQUIRING THE NECESSARY FIRE AND RESCUE APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT TO PROTECT THE HEALTH, SAFETY, AND PROPERTY OF THE TOWN'S RESIDENTS WHILE PROVIDING ENHANCED SERVICES AT REDUCED COSTS WITH TOWN CONTROL?

Said election shall be held between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at St. Lucy Catholic Church (polling place) located at 3510 South Ocean Boulevard, Highland Beach, Florida, 33487.

To be eligible to vote on November 2, 2021, you must be a registered voter in Highland Beach and in Precincts 4128, 4129 and 4156. All Highland Beach registered voters should ensure that their correct address is on file with the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections Office. In accordance with Florida Statutes, Section 101.6103, **ballots cannot be forwarded** by the United States Postal Service.

Below are important dates and deadlines:

- Deadline to register to vote is 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 4, 2021

- Deadline to request a Vote by Mail Ballot be mailed to you is 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 23, 2021
- Deadline to return Vote by Mail Ballot is 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 2, 2021

To register to vote or request a Vote by Mail Ballot, please contact the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections Office <https://www.pbcelections.org/> or 561-656-6200 or take advantage of their Online Mail Ballot Request Service.

The Special Election will be conducted in accordance with the applicable provisions of Florida Statutes and the Charter and Code of the Town of Highland Beach, Florida.
